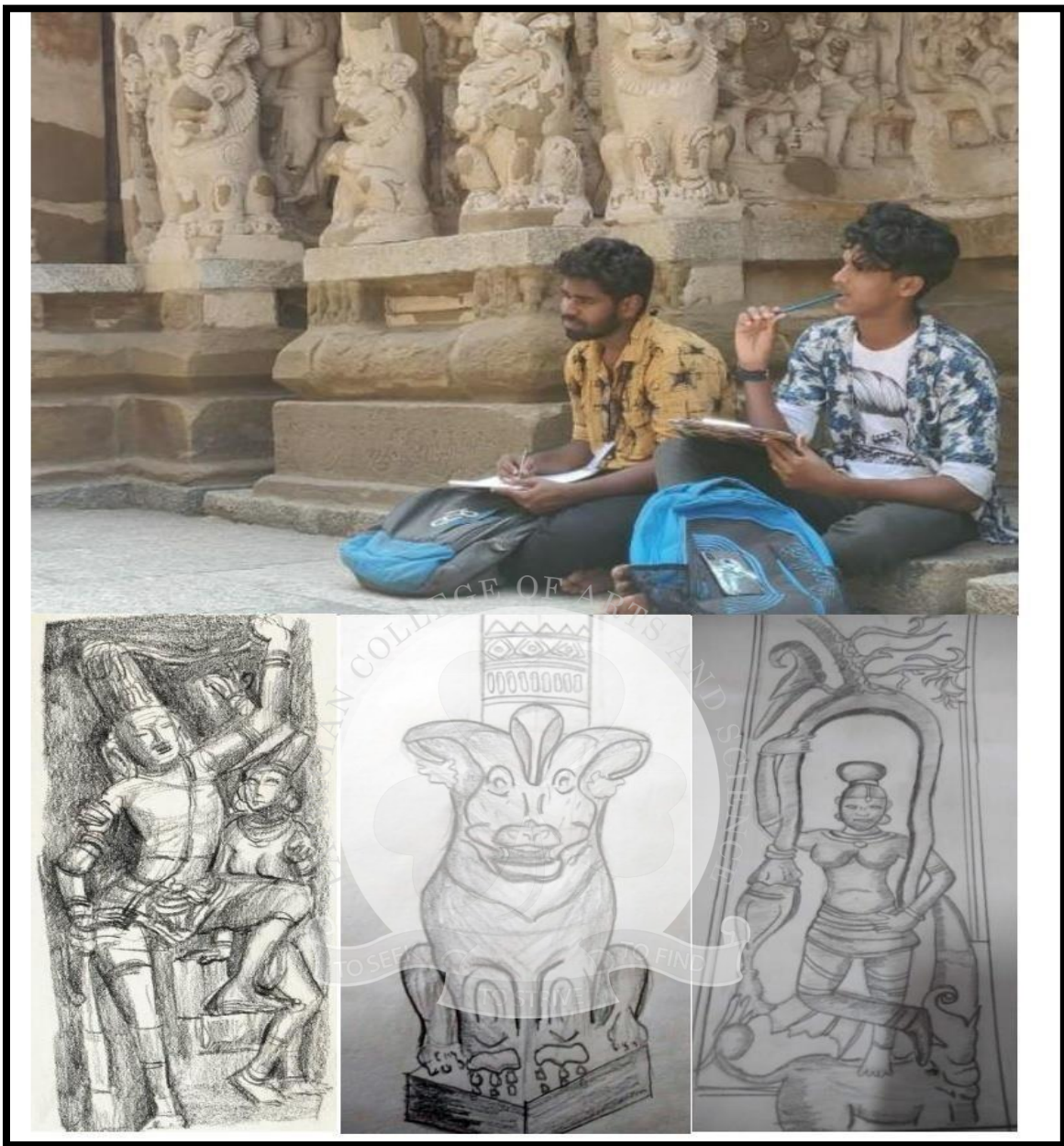
Industrial Visit to Kanchipuram

INTRODUCTION OF THE STUDY TOUR:

The Study Tour is an integral part of the training programme for the students pursuing II year Bachelors in Social Work. Organizing social work in urban areas according to the fields of specializations can assist the students to be super-specialized and perfect in their chosen fields. For many years now, rural and urban development is being treated as a distinct specialization in social work education and a system of field work training in this specialization has already been introduced. Without broad theoretical study and extensive field practices, professional knowledge cannot be developed. Hence, a comprehensive field study and practical demonstrations in a community will perfect social workers, students in their objectives to learn about the society.

The students will understand the social system with the dynamics within and they make a detailed analysis of the regional social system, the approaches, and the strategies of intervention used by the government and non-government organisations. The students develop the capacity to critique the interventions of both the voluntary organisations and the government agencies in relation to the specific group.

There are all possibilities for acquiring skills in planning, organising, implementing through the Study Tour for example: Conscious Use of Time, Communication Skills, Team Spirit, Handling Relationships, Conflicts and Differences of Opinion, Decision Making, Evaluation, Appreciation, Sharing of Resources, Tasks, Coping Skills in Problem Situations, Cooperation and Coordination. The Students Will Be Fully Involved in Planning, Implementing The Plans and Presenting Their Experience in A Workshop on return from the Study Tour.

SUMMARY OF THE ACTIVITIES

THE DESIRE SOCIETY

The Desire Society invited us in a professional and profound manner and gave us a detailed orientation about their organization. Every year they conduct Summer Camps and Supplementary camps for the unprivileged and downtrodden people who can't afford for medical expenses.

HIV/AIDS is a pandemic disease for over three decades. Over 2 million people in India are affected from HIV/AIDS. The Desire Society offers three main programs as follows

SHAHEEN WOMEN RESOURCE AND WELFARE ASSOCIATION

The Shaheen Women's Resource and Welfare Association renders services to women and girl children who are exposed to Domestic violence and child labour for the poor and orphans. This Association was setup in the year 2002. Most of the Young and Unmarried Women are mainly benefitted out of Shaheen's Welfare Programmes and other Resourceful Facilities. Shaheen is a great organization working on the women's rights in the most possible conservative environment. They also have a strong voice over girl child marriages and sheik marriages.

Professionally this is a very good platform for a Social Worker as this creates many opportunities to visit and to get to know about an NGO which mainly aims in the upliftment in the lives of women and girl children. We must ensure the women and girl children thrive to live a dignified life through safe for healthy measures. With more self-confidence self-determination and Non-judgmental attitude, we can sort out the problem within women and find accurate solution to the

problem through case work or Group work methods. Social workers should continue to increase professional knowledge over the uprising issues of the clients and also try to understand the client's situation in an empathetically view without a blaming attitude.

HOME FOR THE DISABLED

This was a new experience to us, so everyone was thrilled in one end and was also pity and pathetic in the other, yet it was challenging because we were learning something new, off the campus. Kindness and Acceptance was the Professional Skill learnt. This is a more professional way of handling the physically challenged. Only with professional skill set, we can provide good hospice, care and concern to these Physically Challenged (Differently-Abled) people so that they also can live in a normal and happy environment. In the same way we should also try to understand the individual's situations and the types of problem he\she is facing.

Seeing all the physically challenged MR patients, crippled, handicapped people made us cry, because we are personally hale and healthy with our good physique. But these people are handicapped, yet they are very happier than us. We on the other hand keep complaining about our lives for the last breath. So we personally learnt that we should be contented with what we are provided with. God has blessed us with all the worldly gift but still we keep complaining about what we don't have the most.

SOCIETY FOR HELPING INTEGRITY NETWORK FOR EMPOWERMENT

As a Social Worker, we should possess certain ethics and moral values for the need of the hour. They didn't want any funding from the politicians. Determination towards their work and goal were perfect and admirable and also to go with it. They created bio degradable sanitary napkins, which became a major achievement for SHINE which brings them the much needed name and fame. It is very good to know that SHINE is indulged in making sanitary napkins for women and young girl children, where sometimes a few of them afford to get them too. These end up in a deadly disease called as cancer, when women use Whisper and Stayfree Secure Sanitary Napkins. So SHINE makes biodegradable sanitary napkins that can easily decompose and is very safe to use too. The services of SHINE NGO are very much appreciated by the government bodies and the local villagers, as SHINE supports women job opportunities and providing necessary education to face the modern generation.
