**Enviro Club 2018-2019**

On 6<sup>th</sup> August 2018, the Enviro club started its series of awareness programmes with a workshop on “Organic Farming”. Mr. Jaganadhan, a farmer, was the resource person. He created awareness amongst the students with the acronym STOP that meant Sugar, Turmeric, Oil and Pulse. He mentioned that these food items must be consumed in an uncontaminated state to avoid health issues.

On October 4<sup>th</sup> 2018, students from various departments gathered in the auditorium with the motive of learning about the plantation process. Mr. Rajeevan, Horticulture officer, the Chief Guest, in his interaction with the students mentioned that the vegetables used for consumption can be grown by any individual very easily in a compact space of their homes without much expense but with a little care. Social activist Ms. Muthu Tamil shared her knowledge on natural ways of cropping and also beekeeping and its benefits. She further demonstrated the method of growing vegetables in small proportions along with Mr. Rajeevan,.
